

Vaccine Passport Policy (Ontario Residents)

As of **September 22, 2021**, Ontario residents will need to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and provide their proof of vaccination along with a piece of photo ID to access Modern Golf facilities.

The Ontario Government has indicated that as of **September 22, 2021**, valid proof of vaccination will include:

- The paper or PDF vaccine receipt (which you received following your 2nd dose) with a government-issued photo ID.

Approximately one month later, the Ontario Government will be launching an enhanced digital vaccine receipt for all to use featuring a unique QR code, which is safer and more secure.

Modern Golf will follow all government guidelines as they develop.

Special Exemptions to Proof of Vaccinations (Ontario Residents)

The Ontario Government has highlighted some specific exemptions, including:

- Individuals who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical exemptions will be permitted entry with a doctor's note until recognized medical exemptions can be integrated as part of a digital vaccine certificate.
- Children who are 11 years of age and younger and unable to be vaccinated will also be exempt from these requirements

Vaccine Passport Policy (B.C. Residents)

As of **September 13, 2021**, B.C. residents will be required to provide proof of immunization of at least one COVID-19 vaccine dose to access “discretionary” social and recreational events including access to the Modern Golf facilities. Proof of a second dose will be required as of **October 24, 2021**.

When using the B.C vaccine card, you may show either the QR code you will receive if you have a smartphone or a printout. Those under the age of 12 are exempt from the vaccine card because they are not yet eligible for the shot.

From **September 13-26, 2021**, B.C. residents will be able to use the paper vaccination records they received at vaccine clinics or pharmacies. Beginning **September 27, 2021** only the BC Vaccine Card will be accepted.
